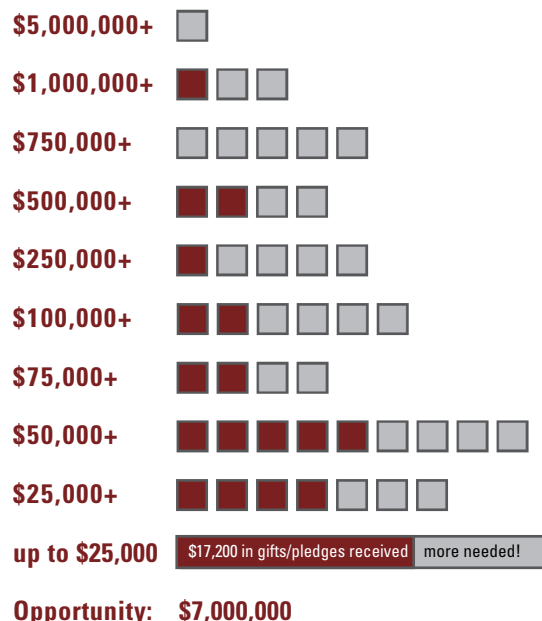

OUR HISTORY

1978

Citizens Memorial Hospital District was formed by a vote of residents.

1982

Citizens Memorial Hospital opened Sept. 28. Donald J. Babb was selected to serve as the administrator. More than \$6.9 million was spent to build and equip the 53-bed hospital.

1986

Established in 1986 as a not-for-profit 501(c)3 entity, Citizens Memorial Health Care Foundation was organized to assist the hospital in the community health system enabling CMH to expand services to its current eight counties.

1991

The hospital expanded The Birth Place to include six labor, delivery, recovery and postpartum (LDRP) rooms.

2023

CMH held a groundbreaking ceremony for the hospital expansion on Sept. 28, 2023, 41 years after the hospital opened its doors.

2024

Construction in progress.
